Note: Art selected for our exhibition requires the artist, school, or parent to deliver the artwork to The Cleveland Foundry, 1831 Columbus Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44113, for the next phase of judging which requires the art to be physically displayed.

Selected Artwork due at The Foundry: Mon. April 14, 2025

Exhibition and Awards Show: Thurs. April 24, 2025, at 5:30 pm

Submission Guidelines and Requirements

Size and Medium

Artwork must be matted and no larger than 24" x 24". All artwork will be hung on the wall for exhibition using 3M hooks. Due to space limitations, we are unable to accept any 3-dimensional artwork.

Accepted Mediums

- Painting
- Drawing and illustration
- Photography
- Digital print
- Mixed media
- Printmaking
- Collage

Artist Statement

AT THE TOP OF YOUR DOCUMENT, YOU MUST INCLUDE:

Name of School, Grade

Title of Artwork

Each submitted artwork must include an artist statement of no more than 200 words explaining its connection to the theme, *The Power of Wind*. The statement should be in a Word document and uploaded with your submission.

Judging Criteria

The judging criteria will focus on the interpretation of the theme in both the artwork and the artist's statement, creativity in concept and presentation, as well as technique and skill demonstration. Artwork from 6th-8th graders and 9th-12th graders will be evaluated separately

Photographing Artwork

- Submit your file in a .jpeg format.
- Place art on a flat surface ensuring neither the camera nor art is tilted. You may consider hanging your art on a wall before photographing. Be sure to check for uneven light and that the image is crisp and without blur before submission.
- Artwork selected for exhibition will be subsequently judged in person.
